REQUIREMENTS

We are looking for individuals that have exceptional food and beverage knowledge, a financial management ability, pay close attention to detail and have high standards of service excellence as well as a passion for the industry.

Candidates should have a minimum of 4 years work experience in a well-recognised five star hotel or world class lodge.

Candidates should speak fluent English. A second language would be preferable. They should be hard-working, have a co-operative manner, be computer literate and have excellent managerial abilities, as well as communication skills. Assertiveness, patience and good organisational skills go hand in hand with this position. A developmental approach to staff is of essence, as well as a clear understanding of the basic labour law and disciplinary procedures. An understanding of housekeeping and maintenance procedures would be beneficial.

South African citizenship is advantageous, however a valid work permit is essential if you are not in possession of a South African ID document.
